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Organizational Background

WeCare for You International Organization was founded in 2015 with a vision to empower vulnerable communities through sustainable development initiatives.

Under the leadership of a committed board and executive team, WeCare for You International Organization continues to expand its impact, promoting gender equality, education, healthcare, and economic empowerment.

Legal Status and Registration Details

WeCare for You International Organization is a legally registered non-profit organization. It was officially registered with the Nigerian Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) in August 2019, to ensure compliance with national legal and regulatory frameworks.

Headquarters and Operational Locations

The organization is headquartered in Nigeria and operates in various regions, with a strong presence in conflict-affected and underserved communities. Its programs extend across multiple states, focusing on initiatives that uplift women and girls, IDP and vulnerable communities through education, skill training, entrepreneurship, and advocacy.

Areas of Focus



1. Health and Wellness

WeCare for You International Organization is committed to improving healthcare access and outcomes, particularly for women, children, and vulnerable populations. The organization implements programs that focus on:

- Maternal and child health
- Disease prevention and health promotion
- Immunization and nutrition programs
- Mental health awareness and support
- Access to essential healthcare services in underserved communities.

2. Education and Capacity Building

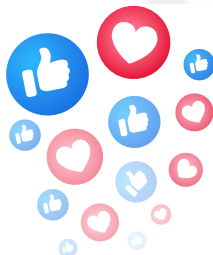

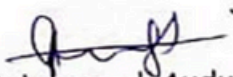
